

TBI SEMINARY GUEST FACULTY PROGRAM

Who: Theology teachers, pastors, and elders who are reformed, evangelical, and have degrees and/or experience in teaching theology.

What: A minimum 10-day mission trip (1 full week of classes) where you will co-teach with an African teacher a seminary class with Trinity Biblical Institute, a government accredited Christian college/seminary or an unaccredited theology conference class.

When: Classes run in Feburary, May, or October, pick your week!

Where: Uganda (Kapchorwa, Gulu, or Kasese), Rwanda (Kigali), or Kenya (Endebess/Kitale).

How: We will arrange everything from start to finish, you raise the funds and prepare to teach! We will help you raise the funds and provide assistance with passport, visa, and medical preparations.



Why: For the glory of God alone as we fulfill the great commission, also to deepen your understanding of and relationship with the African evangelical church, and to help provide funds for pastors in Africa to be trained (more than half of the fee goes toward underwriting the class that you are teaching).

How Much? A 10 day trip is \$5000 all inclusive (includes plane ticket, in-country transportation, in-country meals, cell phone/internet service, everything except for a \$55 visa, airport meals, and your own medical preparations such as shots and malaria medicine). Subtract \$1500 if you buy your own plane ticket. Two weeks of teaching is \$6000, three weeks of teaching is \$7000, etc, just add \$1000 extra for each week. Funds will be sent to TCWM and our accountants will handle the funds and send tax receipts to donors
