- 4 Pray for the accreditation process for Trinity Biblical Institute. We need about \$18,000.00 to complete the process. In Uganda, in order to grant degrees-- we must be accredited. When the accreditation process is complete our three branches of TBI in Uganda and branches in Kenya and Rwanda will be accredited. Thousands of churches are being closed in Rwanda because their pastors do not have accredited degrees!
- 5 Give thanks to God for the many hands that have gotten the library books ready to ship and pray that the books will all get to Africa in His time.
- 6 Pray for clarity of thought and helpful advice from Tailored Fundraising Strategies as we meet with them to refine our fundraising message.
- 7 Ask God to give us helpful outreach efforts to locals in Kapchorwa through the medical clinic or other means. We want to be good neighbors.
- 8 Pray for the staff and administration of the Kaserem Christian Clinic as they seek to establish a firm leadership foundation.
- 9 Pray for the welfare and health of Kiti Peter and his family as he attempts to bring success to the Clinic.
- 10 Pray for OPC missionary Bob Wright, from Livingston University in Mbale, as he seeks to find a way to repair the water borehole at the Clinic.
- 11 Praise God that our bills are paid! Ask the Lord Jesus to provide full funding for the TBI classes in August and September. Approximately \$61,000.00 is needed.
- 12 Pray for wisdom and strength for Pastor Pete as he visits churches in the Atlanta area.
