Dear Christian Friends,

Greetings in Christ! Thank you for your prayers and faithful support for TCWM. God is using these to advance His Gospel.

God's Kingdom is expanding and we press on with the work of discipling and church planting. Here is a little report regarding the progress of our ministry:

TCWM is growing rapidly! In the past year we have started a college in Uganda, Trinity Biblical Institute. We already have over 500 registered students attending two campuses in Eastern and Northern Uganda.

Now, with the support of our board members and many others, we are beginning another phase of our ministry: **reaching the other countries of East Africa.** For 17 years we have worked largely in Uganda. Now our plan is to open five additional Bible Colleges in the remaining countries of East Africa. In 2016, we have plans to begin training Christian leaders in Kenya and South Sudan.



Other sites for TBI will include Burundi, Tanzania, and Rwanda. God has already given us many contacts in these areas; students from South Sudan and Kenya are now attending our schools in Uganda.

At this point we have 21 US church leaders and 8 African church leaders that comprise our core faculty. We need to double their numbers in order to staff five more campuses of Trinity Biblical Institute.

Three weeks ago, we had a team in Uganda teaching some of our best students to preach. The time will come when we have teams in East Africa much of the time.



It is a joy to introduce to you a new full-time missionary with TCWM, PCA Pastor John Griessel. John grew up in Richland, Michigan until age 19 when he was called to faith in Christ and to Christian ministry. He met his wife Jan while attending Bible College in West Virginia and they were married in 1979. He attended Covenant College and Covenant Seminary graduating with a M.Div. in 1989 and an M.A. in Ethics in 2001. John served as a chaplain in the US Army for 21 years; his duties took him to numerous

locations in the US and around the world. God has prepared John in many ways to serve in East Africa, especially through his education and through his military service to be an effective missionary. He has very strong teaching, networking, and administrative skills. John will be living in Uganda about half of each year and during that time he will teach and coach our students and pastors. John already has a weekly radio program on our radio station in Kapchorwa, Uganda. The Griessels served faithfully at Trinity Church Central Oahu during their deployment in Hawaii from 1998 to 2000; they have one grown son, Philip.

In addition, last month TCWM was given 3.5 acres of land in Uganda on which to build a training center and the TCWM headquarters for East Africa. The donor has also challenged us with an additional \$50,000 to construct this facility and provide resources for these new colleges if we can raise an additional \$50,000 before December 31.



What this means is that if you give \$100, actually we will receive \$200. If you give \$1000, we will receive \$2000. If you give \$10,000, we will receive \$20,000. If a total of \$50,000 is given by December 31, we will receive \$100,000 to construct this new facility and help us make disciples in five new countries. People are begging us to come!

Eventually, this new facility will provide housing for our teachers, a library and study center, and a large pavilion where we can instruct up to 500 students. Are you beginning to be overwhelmed? God is more than ready to provide our needs; He is the true God and He can do more than we ask or think or imagine.

Of course the main reason to give is for the glory of Christ. We are confident that Christ will be glorified through this new facility and through the students that will go throughout East Africa to plant new churches.
