Dear Christian Friends,

In the past year TCWM has experienced a growth spurt in its ministry. Many of the efforts of previous years are bearing fruit. Our branches of TBI are experiencing numerical growth. Our faculty is increasing in numbers and more and more church leaders in Central Africa are showing interest. We are especially grateful that churches are being planted by our students. This semester we have sent eight of our students for further training in the hopes that they will be future faculty members.

As a result of this growth, our board is now committed to planting a Bible College in every open country of Central Africa. At this point that means 11 different countries and 13 different branches of Trinity Biblical Institute. The goal is that God's glory would be known among the nations.



In March, we have a team going to our three centers in Uganda and our center in Kenya. In July, for the first time we have two separate groups of faculty spreading throughout Central Africa. **Our main target this year is Rwanda.** We have much work to do in order to start a branch of TBI in the capital, Kigale. Already an advance team has been meeting with our contacts there.


Meanwhile, we have great concerns for our students in Burundi and South Sudan where there is ongoing conflict. The United Nations says over 670,000 South Sudanese refugees are sheltering in Uganda, which also hosts over 45,000 Burundian refugees.

There are numerous unstable countries in Africa. For those countries that are closed we are expanding our Branch of

TBI in Kapchorwa. This includes constructing a large classroom/auditorium for up to 690 students. Our faculty housing, library and kitchen are already complete. Soon we will be able to offer additional courses here throughout the year. (See photo to right.)

We are trying to be faithful to the great commission of Christ, but there is another reason that TCWM's ministry in Central Africa is very important. That reason will be clear as you consider the following map of Africa:





**Do you see the countries in yellow? Those include ten of our eleven target countries. They are open to the Gospel, but threatened by Islam. In the eleven countries we have chosen, there are more than 100 unreached people groups. Most of the countries above which are in green have been taken over by advancing Islam. Much of this great spiritual battle is now in this zone of yellow countries. We have friends, particularly graduates of Westminster Christian Institute Uganda, and others willing to help establish branches of TBI in most of these countries.**
