Dear Brothers and Sisters, Partners in the Gospel,

How do you eat an elephant? One piece at a time!

How do you disciple the nations of Central Africa? One person at a time, one theological school at a time, and by planting one church at a time. All for the Glory of Christ!



At this point we are gearing up for a year of teaching. Pastor John Griessel has been in Uganda for the past couple of months, purchasing additional land for our headquarters, bringing more water to the campus in Eastern Uganda and finishing many projects at our headquarters. Two of our board members, Robin Thomas and Dan Fabrizio, have just returned from Central Africa. Elder Charlie King leaves in March to teach in Trinity Biblical Institute Rwanda and in Trinity Biblical Institute-Kasese, Uganda. John Griessel will return to teach in April and May in Eastern Uganda, Northern Uganda and Kenya. You can see from the picture at the left that good theology produces great doxology.

Meanwhile, many of us are working on the accreditation of TBI. This means most of our teachers and staff and some consultants have tackled this challenge and they are busy writing course descriptions, helping us choose staff, and clearly outlining the path to graduation in four different programs.

In addition to all this, we are involved in two mercy ministries. We are working to bring food and water to a portion of the Pokot tribe in Western Kenya. The food and water arrive tomorrow! And in Eastern Uganda we are working with African friends to refurbish our clinic.

This month I ask you to pray specifically regarding three things:

1. The successful completion of the accreditation process.
2. We have sent two different groups to Congo to do survey work. Now we have a trained team of all African teachers ready to go into Congo to establish a branch of Trinity Biblical Institute. Let us pray that in His time we will go there and make disciples.
3. **Elder Charlie King and Pastor John Griessel** will be leading teams in the near future. They need your prayers and financial support. This is the most pressing need; to send them and our African faculty to five different locations for a week in each place is about \$35,000.
