Dear Partners in the Great Commission,

What is TCWM all about? It is about the Gospel. Our goal is to plant one Bible Institute in each open country of Central Africa, a total of 13 Bible colleges or institutes. **Our desire is to bring the Gospel to the very heart of Africa, make disciples, and plant grace-filled churches. We are now halfway toward our goal** of bringing the Gospel to Central Africa, from the Indian Ocean to the Atlantic Ocean. At present, we have established three branches of Trinity Biblical Institute in Uganda, and one each in Kenya, South Sudan, and Rwanda. Our plans are to go to Congo next, where we already have a faculty and core group. There are about 350,000,000 people in Central Africa and now is a strategic time to reach them with the Gospel of Grace. Many of you have already invested and now your investment is bearing fruit! Thank you.

TCWM is an evangelical mission agency and our mission is this: **to develop Biblical, Christ-centered, self-supporting, and reproducing churches in Central Africa and beyond, through the use of theological education, evangelistic training, cross-cultural study, radio-based proclamation of the Gospel of Grace, and mercy ministries.**

We are starting these Bible schools because of the theological famine in Central Africa with the hope that God will use our schools to train a new generation of Christian leaders. We are making disciples who will be prepared to make more disciples and plant churches. Our other major ministries include Christian radio and medical work.



At present we are building a major campus in Eastern Uganda and plan to use this as a conference center and a place to train Christian leaders across Africa. Already we have completed a guesthouse, kitchens, library, and the auditorium in the picture at the left. In Africa, thousands have responded to the Gospel in faith and repentance, but most have never been taught. In much of Africa, **there is one trained pastor for every 450,000 people.** Already our students speak 19 different languages; our teachers come from several different tribes and are some of the best trained in Africa.

Below is a picture of what our completed Headquarters will look like in Central Africa. It is also the home of Kirwoko Study Center and Trinity Biblical Institute—Kapchorwa, Uganda. This campus serves as the

launchpad for a network of Bible Institutes throughout Central Africa. The three buildings on the left are furnished and complete. The two on the right are our future dormitory and classroom building.



This month and next we will hold classes at five different locations in Central Africa. This week we are in Kigale, Rwanda. (See the photo at right). This is important because the government of Rwanda this month closed more than 700 churches that did not have trained pastors.



There are several ways to help this ministry:

1. Pray for the work of TCWM.
2. Share the work of TCWM with your church leaders or the mission committee of your church.
3. If you know pastors who are retiring, let them know that we desperately need Christian books and commentaries and will have a large container leaving for Africa this summer.
4. TCWM is supported through the generous gifts of Christian churches and God's people. What are the great needs now? Our teachers from the US must raise their expenses to go to Africa and teach. In addition, funds are needed for the accreditation of Trinity Biblical Institute, the replacement of our HVAC system in Dahlongea, and funding for our classes in TBI in Uganda and Kenya. Further, we have completed the plans for a dormitory and classroom building at our headquarters in Africa; we have excellent builders ready to start. This will be our major campus in Africa.
