The Future Impact of Trinity Center for World Mission

Dear Partners in a Mission to Impact the World,

Greetings in Christ! My seven year old grandson, Noah, has been waking me up with growing pains. Do you remember those days?

TCWM is experiencing growing pains too. Because of God's blessings, we are making many disciples, but with this, there are great needs. In this letter I am going to share our greatest need and ask you to be part of the solution. I am going to ask you to give a special gift to blast away obstacles in the path that leads to the planting of many churches.

At this point we have established branches of Trinity Biblical Institute in an area that stretches hundreds of miles across Eastern Africa. We have also enlisted the help of African and American teachers. We give all the glory to Christ.

Our TBI classes are intended to address the greatest need in Central Africa: "theological famine." Yes, there is a famine due to the lack of food for the body and many are hungry, but there is also a theological famine: **There is only one trained pastor for every 450,000 people there!** In Rwanda alone, thousands of churches have been closed largely because their pastors are not trained. This means that a large group



of indigenous African pastors and leaders must be equipped for ministry. They must be taught to preach Biblical truth and lead Christ's church. This great need for trained pastors means that we must grow the theological schools that we have now and complete the accreditation of each one. In addition we continue to have new opportunities to open branches deeper into Africa and we must press forward into the harvest.

Our next TBI classes in Uganda, Kenya, and Rwanda will be held in August and September. Your partnership at this time will enable us to enter and impact the great harvest fields with solid theological training. We need to raise \$61,000 by August 31 to fund this next set of TBI classes and go forward into Central Africa. If we meet this financial goal, we will also be able to begin classes in Aru, Congo.

At TCWM, we want to make a difference for eternity. We want to **impact** the world for the glory of Christ. As we seek to honor Christ, much is at stake. **If God guides us and blesses us, what could be some of the results of this work in the future? What will happen if God allows us to train and send out hundreds of church leaders into the harvest fields of Central Africa?**

1. We will be able to increase the number of Biblically-grounded and reformed pastors graduating in Uganda by 50%. This is possible because of our unique educational model of taking the training to the students in intensive face-to-face classes, with supervised inter-session work. We also believe we can have similar results in other countries of Central Africa.
2. This new generation of reformed pastors and Christian leaders will be taught and mentored to go out from TCWM prepared to teach, preach, counsel and oversee congregations.
3. Hundreds of Gospel-centered churches will be planted by our students. Already one of our students has helped plant 14 churches among the Pokot tribe in Western Kenya; others students have gone into Karamoja, a very difficult mission field, and started two churches. One church started as a result of people in a village listening to our radio station. God is working through TCWM in Central Africa.
4. Thousands of people will grow in the Gospel and many tribes will be reached with the Gospel, resulting in many people who will respond in faith and repentance. As more and more of our students graduate, we believe that we will see an indigenous, church-planting movement that we pray will expand into areas where foreign missionaries cannot go.
5. Trinity Biblical Institute will develop into a growing international school, supported by a well-trained faculty and the facilities necessary to train men and women for ministry.
6. The Kingdom of Christ will advance as TBI graduates go out as missionaries around the world.

So, we have a great need to grow our schools in August and September.
