## March 2019 Prayers and Praise

- 1 Praise God that TBI's faculty taught the Apostles Creed in five locations in Africa over the past seven weeks.
- 2 Ask the Lord to use the teaching the students received about the Apostles Creed to be more faithful pastors and teachers.
- 3 Pray for the upcoming marriage of James Kabugo, our Assistant Coordinator for TCWM in Central Africa.
- 4 Please pray for Doug & Kelly McNutt and their family as they begin their move across the United States this week. They are hauling a large trailer. Pray that the Lord Jesus will keep them safe.
- 5 Ask the Lord to provide a buyer for the McNutt's house in Utah.
- 6 Pray for safe travel for John Griessel as he flies to Uganda today.
- 7 Pray that the Lord will grow TCWM's reserve fund which is set aside for emergency situations.
- 8 Thank God for the pause in the rain so that we can complete the road to our headquarters in Dahlonega.
- 9 Pray for the TCWM Board as we support and lead Trinity Center for World Mission.
- 10 Ask God to give wisdom to John Griessel as he oversees the work at the Kirwoko Study Center in Kapchorwa.
- 11 Pray for James Kisige as he and his crew work on the classroom building and the police house in Kapchorwa.
- 12 Pray that our library of theological books can be shipped to Uganda soon. Pray that the Ugandan government will not hinder their importation.
- 13 Thank the Lord for the faithful work of James Kabugo. Pray that the Lord Jesus will keep Mr. Kabugo a humble man.
- 14 Give praise to God that most of the funds have been given, or pledged, for our classroom building in Kapchorwa, Uganda.
- 15 Ask God to give a good harvest from the planting of crops that will be done at the Kirwoko Study Center this Spring.
- 16 Pray for rain in Uganda so that the crops will grow well and the people will have plenty of food.
- 17 Ask the Lord to give continued spiritual growth through the discipleship studies led by James Kabugo as he travels to places where Trinity Biblical Institute was recently held.
- 18 Pray that the accreditation of Trinity Biblical Institute will be completed by this summer. Ask God to provide funding for offices, for security and for the shipping of a 20-foot container to Uganda. We need approximately \$12,000.
- 19 Praise God that this fall we will complete the teaching of all our courses in a couple of TBI locations. Ask God to provide the funding for these classes.

- 20 Pastor Pete and Charlie King have recently given presentations to churches in Georgia and Virginia about TCWM. Pray that new partnerships will result from these presentations.
- 21 Ask God to provide new members to the TCWM Board.
- 22 TCWM has funded scholarships for 10 students at the African seminary, WCIU. Pray that God will use this time of study to prepare the scholarship students for the Gospel ministry.
- 23 Doug McNutt will be raising funds for the next three months. Pray for joyful donors!
- 24 There is interest among the Pokot tribe for Trinity Biblical Institute. Pray that God will supply the funding.
- 25 Pray that TCWM will wisely use the financial gifts that are received so that the most urgent needs in Africa to address the theological famine will be met.
- 26 Pray for the wise utilization of the Kirwoko Study Center.
- 27 Ask God for the addition to the dormitory at the Kirwoko Study Center to be completed soon.
- 28 Pray for the clinic we sponsor. On an average, one baby is born there per day.
- 29 Pray for Kiti Peter, the director of the clinic.
- 30 Pray for funding for TBI in the Congo. There is interest there.
- 31 Ask God to help Doug McNutt and his family to get settled in to their new surroundings. Doug begins his employment with TCWM tomorrow.
