- 1 Thank God for the teaching of Trinity Biblical Institute in Kigali, Eastern Rwanda this week.
- 2 Praise God that TCWM hired a new full-time missionary, Pastor Doug McNutt.
- 3 Pray for Pastor McNutt as he prepares to return to the US tomorrow after teaching in Uganda, Kenya and Rwanda for the last few weeks.
- 4 Ask God to give board member Robin Thomas safe travels as she departs today for a month in Kenya and Uganda with her charity.
- 5 Please pray for TBI instructor, Pastor Fred Kibaye as his son Zedekiah suffers from encephalitis. Even though Zedekiah is well now the hospital will not release him, because \$1250 is owed. Pastor Kibaye and his wife asked the hospital to let them work off the bill, but the hospital said they have no jobs for them. Zedekiah has been in the hospital for five months.
- 6 TBI begins today in Kapchorwa. Pray that instructors and students would be prepared.
- 7 Give praise to God that Pastor Pete is feeling stronger than he did before his heart attack. Pray that he will be able to sleep better.
- 8 Give thanks to God that the classroom building in Kapchorwa is almost completed. Pray the Lord Jesus will provide the needed funding.
- 9 Praise God for the construction of the police station and new entrance to our headquarters in Uganda.
- 10 Please pray for Charlie Anderson, a brother of Pastor Pete. Charlie had heart surgery the same day as Pastor Pete and is continuing to have heart value problems.
- 11 Board members Charlie & Jane King and Dave & Nancy Olson are in the process of moving. Please pray that their current houses will sell soon.
- 12 We give thanks to God for the work of Happy Roberts and John Ssali for the accreditation of TBI. We only lack the cost of safety equipment, partitions for 4 to 6 offices and the shipping of our theological library to Africa.
- 13 Give thanks to God for the 1200 students of Trinity Biblical Institute who, since January, were taught the basics of the Christian faith and a course in church planting.
- 14 Kaserem Christian Clinic needs funding for running water and electricity. Pray that God's people will contribute to this great need!
- 15 Pray for today's fund raiser for Kaserem Clinic hosted by Charlie King's son Ben and daughter in law Sarah in Winston-Salem, NC. Pray that there will be many new donors for the clinic.
- 16 Praise God for Bible studies with approximately 400 students attending in five different locations in Africa since January.
- 17 We thank God TCWM has increased its mailing list. Pray for Pastor Pete and Pastor McNutt as they seek to raise funds for TCWM.
- 18 Pray for Martin Mongusho as he watches over the Kirwoko Study Center and KTR Radio in Uganda.

- 19 Thank the Lord Jesus for the ministry of KTR radio which airs the Gospel to Uganda and beyond.
- 20 Please pray for Trinity Biblical Institute which begins in Kasese today.
- 21 Thank God that we have been able to provide approximately 15,000 meals for our TBI students since January of this year.
- 22 We are grateful for the labors of Elder Moses Bagey and Pastor Fred Kabenge who prepared an agreement with the Ugandan government making the future shipment of our library and medical supplies less costly.
- 23 Praise God for the completion of the fourth translation of the Westminster Shorter Catechism.
- 24 Continue to pray for God to provide new TCWM Board members for our US board. We are encouraged that we have two possible candidates.
- 25 TCWM has a growing number of volunteers in Georgia. Give thanks to God for His goodness!
- 26 Since January donations to TCWM have provided salaries and transportation of our faculty so that they could teach twice in five different locations in Africa. Pray that God will provide more donations to fund the next set of classes in the Fall.
- 27 Give praise to God for the gift of 24 laptop computers, 50 monitors and other equipment for a computer lab at our headquarters in Uganda.
- 28 Ask the Lord Jesus to provide the funds to send our library of books to Uganda.
- 29 Since the beginning of the year we have been able to feed about 1000 hungry people from the Pokot tribe. Pray that God will feed them physically and spiritually.
- 30 Pray that Pastor McNutt and his family will get settled in to their new home in Alabama soon.
- 31 We give thanks that TCWM was able to purchase a roof for a new elementary school in Africa.
