Dear Friends and Partners in the work of the Gospel,

God did it! To Him be all the Glory!

It has been a great challenge, but in four years God has enabled us to build a campus where about 700 students can receive theological education at one time. We now have an auditorium that seats 450 and classrooms that seat a total of 240 students. We now have a place in Uganda from which we can continue to reach Central Africa.

How did all this happen?

1. We started with prayer and carefully planned.
2. For the Glory of Christ, we asked you to support Trinity Biblical Institute.
3. We carefully selected our faculty and students.
4. We assembled a library of approximately 8000 volumes.

5. We started building, first, a large auditorium and administrative offices.



6. Then we constructed the library, guesthouse, and two kitchens.



7. Then we started on the police station and a new entrance to our campus.



8. Then we prepared a garden to feed our students and faculty and become self-supporting.



9. Then we constructed the classroom building.



10. One person has worked harder on this campus than anyone else, Chaplain John Griessel. John has been our chief fundraiser, planner, designer, and construction supervisor. He has worked with the local authorities to bring water to our site and build a road to the doorstep of our campus. Thank you, John.





In addition, we are so grateful to our builder, James Kisige, and Goshen Construction. They built most of the buildings using hand-hewn stone; these facilities will be used long into the future by Trinity Biblical Institute, Kirwoko Study Center and many others.

Soon we will be able to host conferences at this new campus as well as teach the classes of Trinity Biblical Institute. For the next two months, we will be teaching in Uganda, Kenya, and Rwanda.

To construct our headquarters compound has stretched us financially; our need in the next seven weeks is \$27,000. This will fund the remaining need to teach classes in all six different locations.

Thank you again for your generous support. We are in this for the long run. Pray for us as we develop plans to continue across Central Africa. And please continue to pray in April and May for our team that will be teaching a course on church planting in several locations.
