- 1 Praise God that Pastor Pete celebrates 70 years of life this week! Thank God for how He has used Pastor Pete to further His Kingdom.
- 2 Thank God that TCWM is expanding Trinity Biblical Institute Centers in several countries of East and Central Africa. In the whole of Africa, there are about 3,000 tribes, speaking more than 2,000 different languages. TCWM is contributing to Christ's mission of gathering into His Kingdom that great multitude which no one will be able to number coming from every nation, tribe, peoples and languages that will appear standing before the throne and before the lamb clothed in white robes! (Rev. 7:9)
- 3 Pray for Pastor Doug McNutt as he prepares to leave for Uganda on August 5<sup>th</sup>. Pastor McNutt will be teaching preachers to preach in the Trinity Biblical Institute classes.
- 4 Pray for the TBI students in Uganda and Kenya that will be participating in the August-September session of classes. Trinity Biblical Institute will be taught in five locations.
- 5 Ask the Lord Jesus to give Pastor McNutt a safe trip to Africa.
- 6 Pray for the fund raising efforts of Pastor Pete and Pastor McNutt. Tuition and fees per TBI student this session is \$105.00. Funding is still needed for this semester's student tuition and for the teacher's salaries.
- 7 Praise God 235 boxes of theological books are ready for shipment to Africa. Give thanks to God for the funds that have been provided for their shipment. Pray for the tax-exempt letter to come through so we can ship the books into Uganda duty free.
- 8 Thank the Lord Jesus that the classroom building in Kapchorwa is nearly complete. It should be ready for the first classes in September.
- 9 Construction has begun on a road that connects our African Headquarters to the main road. \$8,000 of a needed \$12,000 has been given to this project. Pray the project will be completely funded.
- 10 Give thanks to God for one of our new board members---Steve Shuler. Steve is the chairman of the audit committee.
- 11 Pray that God will bring spiritual fruit from the proclamation of the Gospel via our radio ministry. Pray that those working at the station will be faithful to God.
- 12 Pray that the Lord Jesus will provide a person to be the resident overseer of the Kirwoko Study Center in Uganda.
- 13 Thank God for Keith Weber, a new board member, who serves on the Governance Committee.
- 14 Pray that God will give energy and grace to James Kabugo as he travels and holds Bible study classes with students between TBI sessions.
- 15 Ask God to give wisdom to the U.S. TCWM Board as they prepare to search for a new executive director.
- 16 Thank God that the McNutt's and the Olson's houses sold. Continue to pray for the sale of the King's house.
- 17 Give thanks for the volunteer workers in Dahlonaga.
- 18 Approximately \$29,000 of the needed \$47,000 has been given for the next group of classes which will meet in five different locations. We hope to train 600 Christian leaders how to preach. Pray that God will provide the needed funding.
- 19 Pray for Pastor Milton Lipa and his leadership on the TCWM Limited Board in Uganda.

- 20 Pray for improved relations and improved physical health in the Kapchorwa community through the ministry of Kiti Peter and the Kaserem Clinic.
- 21 Praise God that we have a growing number of American pastors who are willing to teach in Africa.
- 22 Ask the Lord Jesus to help us as we approach churches to support TCWM financially.
- 23 We praise God for a generous donor who has committed to giving a matching gift toward the construction of faculty housing at our headquarters in Africa. He has pledged to match every gift up to a total of \$14,000 so that this \$28,000 building can be constructed. If you send a gift please write on the check, "Faculty Housing—Matching Gift".
- 24 Pray for the health of Pastor Pete and his family.
- 25 We have started writing training manuals that will cover all the courses we teach at Trinity Biblical Institute. As the manuals are completed we plan to post them on a new website for our students. Pray for those who are compiling the manuals.
- 26 Ask God to give wisdom and insight to our Ugandan Board.
- 27 We give thanks to God that our main campus in Africa has been connected to the national water system.
- 28 In Dahlonega, GA, we are busy putting gravel on a new road to our U.S. headquarters. Thank God for the ability to do this.
- 29 Pray for Pastor Pete as he prepares to travel to Uganda. Pray for his safety and good health while he is in Africa. Pray for his wife Martha, daughter Carrie and grandson Noah while he is away from them.
- 30 We have started registering students for our new curriculum, which begins in January 2020. A representative of the National Council for Higher Education in Uganda will travel with us in August and September to visit each of our teaching centers. Pray that the courses will be approved for accreditation.
- 31 We thank God for all of those who work faithfully for TCWM in Africa. Pray for continued improvements in coordinating and reporting budgets.
