- 3 Thank God for Kityo Denis, a TCWM sponsored student at Westminster Christian Institute Uganda, who is running a gospel outreach ministry at Kaserem Christian Clinic. Thank God for those who have come to faith in Christ. Pray that they will grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
- 4 Praise God that the Ugandan government has begun opening churches with limitations, some schools and some businesses. Pray for more to be allowed to open.

- 6 Give praise to the Lord that Pastor Francis Owoyesigire’s church was able to reopen. Thank God that Pastor Francis was able to preach over the radio for the past 6 months.
- 7 Thank God that TCWM-US board member and Mission to the World missionary Bruce Sinclair and his wife Pam were able to get a repatriation flight to the U.S. While on Home Ministry Assignment, Bruce is serving as pulpit supply at Holy Cross Church (PCA) in Tucson, AZ where Bruce and Pam’s son serves as a ruling elder.

- 21 Give thanks that one of our supporting churches is sponsoring a mobile medical clinic at our campus in Kapchorwa in cooperation with the Kaserem Clinic director, Kiti Peter.
- 22 Pray that TCWM will be able to reduce expenses as we wait for TBI classes to begin in Africa.
- 23 Praise God for the work of Pastor Doug McNutt in putting together a book with contributions from some of our TCWM leaders to help our TBI students grow spiritually.
- 24 Ask God to give peace and joy to TBI Principal Fred Kabenge as he guides the staff in Kapchorwa.
