- 5 Pray for Pastor Patrick Komagum’s school run by his church Grace Awarana in Gulu. The flood-damaged school building needs government directed improvements in order to continue functioning.
- 6 Pray for the safety of Pastor Doug McNutt and Pastor Pete Anderson as they travel visiting supporting individuals and supporting churches.
- 7 Praise God for the active discipleship work of James Kabugo to support various church communities in Africa to grow in faith in Christ.

- 12 Pray that God will provide additional passionate and enthusiastic board members to serve God through the ministry of TCWM.
- 13 Pray for the family of Pastor Stephen Ayela, a TBI coordinator in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Pastor Ayela recently died with cancer.
- 14 Give praise to God that Renaissance Classical Christian School in Fayetteville, NC where TCWM – US Board Chairman Charlie King teaches has been able to have in-person classes without problems.
- 15 Thank God for TBI Principal, Elder Fred Kabenge. Pray that God will give him and the rest of the staff, teachers and coordinators in Africa wisdom.
- 16 Central and Northern Uganda has been experiencing flooding. Pray for the flood victims, including Pastor James Lonyera and his church Christian Fellowship of the Kitgum in Northern Uganda. The building is on the verge of being washed away.
