- 3 Give thanks to God for the healing of our sister Margaret Ajju from the COVID virus!
- 4 Ask God to comfort the families of our students and friends who died of COVID-19. Pray for the healing of members of the TBI team who have contracted the virus.
- 5 Please pray for Pastor James Yiga, a leader of the Presbyterian Church in Uganda, he was hospitalized with COVID-19.
- 6 Praise God for the completion of many of our study guides for Trinity Biblical Institute classes.
- 7 Pray that our TCWM board will wait patiently on our Lord for a new president. Ask God to give the board discernment and unity in making a decision.
- 8 Give thanks to God that our staff and board on both continents can pray together each week online. Pray that we will closer in the Lord through these meetings.

- 20 Thank God for Chaplain Rich Young who has been a member of the Presidential Search Committee.
- 21 Ask the Lord Jesus to enable the TCWM-US board members to prepare well for our January 23rd face to face board meeting.
- 22 Pray that God will keep James Kabugo safe as he travels in Kenya, Uganda and Rwanda.
- 23 Ask God to give the TCWM-US Board, wisdom, as we meet today in Dahlonaga, GA.
- 24 Praise God for the faithful ministry of Martin Mangusho as he oversees our campus and helps re-establish a church in Kapchorwa.
- 25 Our conference classes are scheduled to begin today in Kapchorwa. Please pray that all will go well!
- 26 Give thanks to God for Christ Covenant Church in Greensboro, NC, one of our supporting churches.
- 27 Praise God that the TBI recruiting team has been able to reach prospective students. Pray that the students will be kingdom-minded and genuinely called to ministry.
