- 1 The accredited program of Trinity Biblical Institute is scheduled to open today in Kapchorwa, Uganda and the conference classes begin in Endebess, Kenya. Give thanks to God! Pray for all the staff and students to be protected from the COVID virus. The classes in Kapchorwa are scheduled to meet all month and those in Endebess are scheduled for February 1 – 5.
- 2 Give thanks that the conference classes held last week at the TBI Center in Kapchorwa went well. Certificates were awarded to those who had completed 4 years of course work.
- 3 Pray for safety for Pastor Doug McNutt and the ministry team as they travel in Uganda and Kenya this month leading TBI classes. Specifically, pray that they will be protected from COVID.
- 4 Praise God for Principal Fred Kabenge and his staff in the preparations they made to reopen the TBI classes. Pray that God will continue to sustain them in all their work for TCWM.
- 5 Pray for Pastor Milton Lipa, chairman of the TCWM-Ugandan board and member of the TCWM-US board. Pray for Pastor Lipa’s health and for wisdom for his doctors.
- 6 Pray for Pastor Ochen Bosco and his wife Irene from Gulu. Pastor Ochen was scheduled to begin graduate work at African Reformed Theological Seminary in Kampala last week, under a TCWM scholarship. He and his wife were in a serious boda boda accident. Pastor Ochen has a compound fracture in his leg. Pray for recovery and support during this difficult time.
- 7 Give thanks that God has provided new venues for TBI conferences in Endebess and Kasesse. The former locations were no longer available due to COVID complications.
- 8 The TBI conference program is scheduled to begin today in Gulu, Uganda. Pray for the staff, faculty and students. The classes end on February 12<sup>th</sup>.
- 9 Pray that God will provide all the funding for this month’s TBI traveling expenses.
- 10 Thank God for one of our supporting churches, New Harmony Presbyterian Church of Alcolu, SC.
- 11 Pray for Denis Kitiyo as he leads the prayer and evangelization efforts at Kaserem Christian Medical Clinic. As a result of his efforts, several of the patients are coming to embrace faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, and have joined either the local Presbyterian Church of Uganda near the clinic or other evangelical churches.
- 12 Ask God to provide the resources to have indoor running water and plumbing at the Kaserem Clinic. Give thanks that the clinic was able to connect to the national electricity grid this past year.

- 13 Praise God that thirteen of the TBI study guides for the two diploma courses of TBI have been developed and published for use of the students.
- 14 Give God thanks for our newest TCWM – US board member Mr. Bill Long.
- 15 Ask God to allow the TBI conference classes scheduled to open today in Kasese, Uganda to begin smoothly. The classes are scheduled to end on February 19<sup>th</sup>.
- 16 Pray for good health for Pastor Pete as he works raising funds for TCWM and as he cares for his family. Pray that God will bring much fruit from Pastor Pete’s labors.
- 17 Ask God to protect and encourage Pastor McNutt’s family as he is away this month. Pray for Kelly and the children as they prepare to move to Dhalonega this summer.
- 18 Pray for the families of our deceased TCWM staff, students and faculty. Pray that God will continue to sustain and support them. Give thanks that God has provided TCWM with the funds to assist our staff with food and medical assistance during the COVID pandemic.
- 19 Pray for the long-term sustainability of TBI by setting up income generating projects that can reinforce the donations and grants.
- 20 Give thanks for supporting church Redeemer Presbyterian in Evans, GA.
- 21 Pray for a quick end to the COVID pandemic so that TBI training programs can resume in Rwanda and expand to other areas.

The Ugandan government has sought to restrain them. Pray that God will bring an end to their fraudulent activities.
- 25 Praise God for the successful completion of the TCWM Presidential Search! In April, Pastor Doug McNutt will be the new President. Pastor Pete Anderson will be continuing on with TCWM as missionary, pastor, and teacher. He will be the Chancellor of TBI in Africa.
- 26 Please pray for Martin Mangusho as he manages KTR radio and the TBI-Kapchorwa campus. Pray that God will protect him and sustain him.
- 27 Give thanks for James Kabugo associate coordinator of TCWM Central Africa. Pray that God will keep him safe and strengthen him.
